I am directed by the Acting Governor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th of November and to inform you that His Excellency has granted you permission to import a consignment of Alfalfa from Chile.

2. I am to invite your attention to Article 7 of the Regulations of the 16th of August, 1925, and to warn you that unless the restrictions regarding the importation of fodder are fully complied with the alfalfa will be destroyed.
