Dear Sir,

I propose taking a wire haired fox terrier to Port Stanley, Falkland Islands. At the expiration of the quarantine - 6 weeks I believe - he will be removed to my home at Port Darwin in the Falklands.

Red 2. I enclose a Veterinary certificate.

He is a wire haired fox terrier dog and I Red 1. enclose his pedigree.

At present the dog is living at 35, Richmond Hill Road, Aberdeen.

At the end of the quarantine at Port Stanley he will be taken to Port Darwin, Falkland Islands.

The dog will be taken on board the Reina del Pacifico sailing January 18th, 1933 and will be landed at Port Stanley, Falkland Islands.

The Reina del Pacifico arrives in Port Stanley Falkland Islands February 12th, 1933.
