

I have the honour to report that at the request of the Under Secretary of State, Colonial Office, we have ordered for shipment to the Director of Agriculture, Stanley, a consignment of 56 lb. of clover seed.

- 2. This seed has been ordered in conjunction with Mr. W. Davies of the Welsh Plant Breeding Station,
 Aberystwyth, and the purchase has been made from
 Messrs. Eastes and Loud Ltd. of Ashford, Kent.
- 3. The seed ordered comprises the following mixture and statement of seed analysis is attached:-
 - 28 lb. of Grade A 1938 crop wild white clover seed @ 3s.3d. lb.
 - 28 lb. of Kent Old Pasture crop wild white clover seed @ 3s.9d. lb.
- 4. We expect to arrange shipment in a boat sailing from this country towards the end of October.
- 5. At the request of Mr.W.Davies we have asked the Director of the Rothamsted Experimental Station, Harpenden, to prepare cultures necessary for the sowing of this seed and in this connection I append an extract from a letter from the Director of the Station -

"We have prepared cultures on artificial media in test tubes, one of which will inoculate 14 lb. of seed, and another set in soil which may last the journey better. The soil should be mixed with skim milk and each bottle used for 28 lb. of seed."

These cultures will be shipped at the same time as the seed in the vegetable room of the steamer.
