I have received the package from Messrs Parke Davis & Co, and find on opening same, they have only sent 10 doses of Mollin (Subcutaneous) Their own invoice distinctly states 10 single doses of Interpalpebral and does not mention either Subcutaneous or the 10 ~~doses~~ tubes of 10 doses each, asked for on Indent No 15. Neither are the 24 Chloral hydrate balls, the 10 lbs of Mag Sulph, 10 Pilsner of Paris tomorrow or the gallon of Jys fluid included.

I would suggest that the crown agents be wired to inquire into the reason of the change of Mollin also the omitting of the other items. The Mollin is most urgent, particularly Inter Palpebral ~~20.7.20~~ Over

If they have not the 10 dose tubes, 90 single dose tubes would do quite well for the Interpalpebral malleum.

Sir

I have the honor to submit for the approval of The Administrator the following suggestions regarding the importation of horses to this Colony from Argentine and Chile . I think it advisable to test the same for Glanders as this disease is always liable to occur in any country, especially where there there is not good supervision of stock .

To enable me to do this it would be necessary to hold them in some place for at least 24 hours . They could be inoculated on board the ship and then removed to a quarantine station for observation and if not reacting at the end of 24 hours could be released.

To enable me to do this I should require to keep in stock about

- 10 single doses of mallein
- 10 tubes containing 10 doses each
- 1 hypodermic syringe Parke Davis No 3 with extra barrel
- 1 adaptor for Schimmel pattern hypodermic needles
- 12 Needles " " " " (2 tubes)

Also as there is always liable to be the need for a few simple drugs and dressings it would be as well to obtain at the same time

- 24 Alloetic balls 8 Drachmes
- 24 Chloral hydrate balls 1 ounce
- 10 Lbs magnesium sulph
- 6 Tubes Vet hypodermic tablets Arecoline 1 Grain
- 6 Tubes Vet hypodermic tablets Morphine sulphate 2 Grain
- 10 Bandages plaster of Paris 3 In width



Gentlemen,

Replying to your communication of the 21st inst.,we desire to say that the question of the supply of interpalpebral Mallein raised by the Colonial Government is a somewhat complicated one,in view of the fact that since we submitted our quotation on the 30th April last we have been advised by our Detroit House that they have added to their list Mallein in smaller quantities especially for the intra-dermal-palpebral test. We may mention that Mallein Solution for the sub-cutaneous test and for the intra-dermal-palpebral test is exactly the same product,the only difference being the quantities used respectively.

When submitting our tender,we listed and stocked Mallein solution in 1 c.c.vials,but our Detroit House also listed tubes containing 10 doses,that is 10 c.c. For the intra-dermal-palpebral test,the dose is from 0.1 c.c. to 0.2 c.c.whereas for the sub-cutaneous test the dose is 2.c.c. The only question,therefore,is the sub-division of the doses.

The new sizes specially for intra-dermic use are bulbs containing 1 c.c.equal to five doses,and bulbs containing 5 c.c. representing 25 doses. The latter size package,however,is not

stocked in this country. We think, therefore, the indenter will find that the article we have supplied will conform to his requirements, subject to his dividing the doses suitably; even with the more recently introduced packages the quantity is to be sub-divided in a similar way.

We trust that this explanation will be considered satisfactory and remain,
