The method to be used for taking the impression of the branding-iron is as follows:-

First clean the face of the brandingiron, then ink it over, and take the impression by pressing the face of the iron down lightly on a cloth or blanket.

The impression of the brand on paper must on no account be marked over with ink after the impression has been taken.
