STOCK NOTICE.

All Stanley owners of cattle, sheep or horses, are hereby notified that they are required to submit to the Chief Inspector of Stock, before the 31st of December, 1926, a correct impression of the brand which they are using on their stock.

The method to be used for taking the impression of the branding-iron is as follows :-

First clean the face of the branding-iron, then ink it over, and take the impression by pressing the face of the iron down lightly on a cloth or blanket.

The impression of the brand on paper must on no account be marked over with ink after the impression has been taken.
