HISTORY This cow calved with assistance on 13th October at 6 p.m. with a live heifer calf, which was weakly and possibly 1 month premature. Her temperature on 14th Oct. was 105°F and full doses of antibiotics were given, she was off food by the evening and a bran mash was given. she was seriously ill on the next day and further antibiotic treatment was given, temp. 109°F, mastitis also present. 




