1. All and any business undertaken by LEP (BLOODSTOCK) LIMITED (hereinafter called "the Company") is transacted subject to the conditions hereinafter set out each of which shall be deemed to be incorporated in and to be a condition of any agreement between the Company and its Customers. The Company is not a common carrier and only deals with animals/goods subject to these conditions. No agent or employee of the Company has the Company's authority to alter or vary these conditions.
2. Customers entering into transactions of any kind with the Company expressly warrant that they are either the owners or the authorised agents of the owners of any animals/goods to which the transaction relates and further warrant that they are authorised to accept and are accepting these conditions not only for themselves but also as agents for and on behalf of all other persons who are or may thereafter become interested in the animals/goods.
3. Any instructions given to the Company may in the absolute discretion of the Company be complied with by the Company itself by its own servants performing part or all of the relevant services or by the Company employing or instructing or entrusting the animals/goods to others on such conditions as such others may stipulate to perform part or all of the services.
4. Subject to express instructions in writing given by the Customer, the Company reserves to itself absolute discretion as to the means, route and procedure to be followed in the handling, storage, and transportation of animals/goods. Further, if in the opinion of the Company it is at any stage necessary or desirable in the Customer's interests to depart from those instructions, the Company shall be at liberty to do so.
5. Pending forwarding or delivery, animals/goods may be warehoused or otherwise held at any place or places at the sole discretion of the Company and the cost thereof shall be for the account of the Customer.
6. The Company is entitled to retain and be paid all brokerages, commission, allowances and other remunerations customarily retained by or paid to Shipping and Forwarding Agents (or Freight Forwarders) and Insurance Brokers.
7. Quotations are given on the basis of immediate acceptance and subject to the right of withdrawal or revision. If any changes occur in the rates of freight, insurance premiums, rates of exchange, or other charges applicable to the animals/goods, quotations and charges shall be subject to revision accordingly with or without notice.
8. The Customer shall be deemed to be bound by and to warrant the accuracy of all descriptions, values and other particulars furnished to the Company for Customs, Consular and other purposes and he undertakes to indemnify the Company against all losses, damages, expenses and fines arising from any inaccuracy or omission, even if such inaccuracy or omission is not due to any negligence.
9. The Customer shall be liable for any duties, taxes, imposts, levies, deposits or outlays of any kind levied by the authorities at any port or place for or in connection with the animals/goods and for any payments, fines, expenses, loss or damage incurred or sustained by the Company in connection therewith.
10. When animals/goods are accepted or dealt with upon instructions to collect freight, duties, charges or other expenses from the consignee or any other person the Customer shall remain responsible for the same if they are not paid by such consignee or other person.
11. No insurance will be effected except upon express instructions given in writing by the Customer and all insurances effected by the Company are subject to the usual exceptions and conditions of the policies of the insurance company or underwriters taking the risk. The Company shall not be under any obligation to effect a separate insurance on each consignment but may declare it on any open or general policy. Should the insurers dispute their liability for any reason the insured shall have recourse against the insurers only and the Company shall not be under any responsibility or liability in relation thereto notwithstanding that the premium upon the policy may not be at the same rate as that charged by the Company or paid to the Company by its Customer.
12. 17. The Company is under no liability to feed and water livestock unless by special request. The Company may, however, in the absence of such request or agreement, arrange the feeding and watering of livestock at the expense of the Customer if, in the opinion of the Company, it is reasonable to do so without incurring liability for any consequences thereof.
18. Instructions to collect payment on delivery (C.O.D.) in cash or otherwise are accepted by the Company upon the condition that the Company in the matter of such collection will be liable for the exercise of reasonable diligence and care only.
19.
