- Any instructions given to the Company may in the absolute discretion of the Company be compled with by the Company itself by its own servents recforming part or all of the relevant services or by the Company employing or instructing of entrusting the animal/doods to others on such conditions as such others may stipulate to perform part or all of the services
- subject to express instructions in writing given by the Customer, the Company reserves to itself absolute discretion as to the means, route and procedure to be followed in the handling, storage, and transportation of animals/goods. Further, if in the opinion of the Company it is at any stage, necessary or discribe in the Customer's interests to depart from those instructions, the Company shall be at
- Pending forwarding or delivery, animals/goods may be warehoused or otherwise he at any place or places at the sole discretion of the Company and the cosmhere shall be for the account of the Customer.
- The Company is entitled to retain and be paid all brokerages, commission, allowances and other remunerations customarily retained by or paid to Shipping and Forwarding Agents (or Freight Forwarders) and Insurance Brokers.
- Quotations are given on the basis of immediate acceptance and subject to the right of withdrawal or revision. If any changes occur in the rates of freight, insurance premiums, rates of exchange, or other charges applicable to the animals/goods, quotations and charges shall be subject to revision accordingly with or without
- The Customer shall be deemed to be bound by and to warrant the accuracy of all descriptions, values and other particulars furnished to the Company for Customs. Consular and other purposes and he undertakes to indemnify the Company against all lorses, damages, expenses and fines arising from any inaccuracy or omission, even if such inaccuracy or omission is not due to any negligence.
