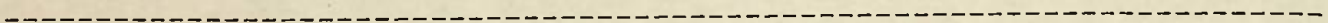

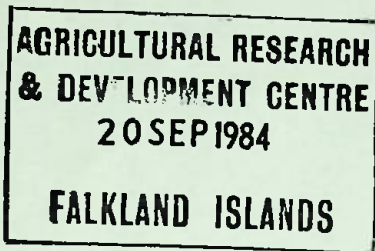

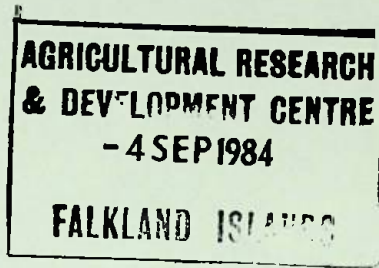

You may be interested to know that our "Jersey Cow" gave birth to a very healthy "Bull Calf" in the early hours on Saturday the 6th October, according to the date of been served by the bull, she should of calved on the 9th which is three days before time, but in spite of this three days premature both mother and calf are in very good fettle, although I must stress that the cow is not as fat as I would of liked to of seen her before calving, but I suppose by taken every think into re-consideration, and comparing her with our other cows, I suppose one can say that she has done extremely well.

How-ever as I mention in your question-naire that all three of the Jersey animals adapted them-selves to the South Atlantic winter extremely well, and we are more than pleased with their hardiness, infact it was only on one occasion did we stable the cow and her six-month old calf for a couple of nights during a heavy snow blizzard, but apart from this they remained sheltered under the lee of the shearing shed and house on snowy days, as there are no other form of shelter on here, such as hedges which musted clarify the hardiness of the Jersey animal, they were ofcourse fed night and morning on tussock grass and hay which kept them in fairly good condition, infact the bull appears to be a very hardy animal which he has held his condition right through the winter, he is also a very tame natured animal even at feeding time which is a good thing, but ~~we have had no problem in~~ we have had no problem in bringing them through this past winter.

We have had several inquiry from different people with regards to the bull calves and we have now decided to sell our pedigree Jersey for £85 and Ayrshire cross for £45, all proceeds from the sale of these animals will go towards the importation of another Jersey Bull, which is required as it is our intentions to establish a "South Atlantic Jersey" Herd.

At the moment she is in my keeping due to the Boss being away on leave in the U.K. and he doesn't expect to get back until sometime in October.

Ness has spent most of her time here in a pen with another dog and has about one hours exercise a day. She is fed every evening on roughly $1\frac{1}{4}$ lbs of raw meat and bone and at the moment she weighs 37 lbs and looks in a very healthy condition. She doesn't seem to like been shut in, so it has been necessary to leave her kennel door open at night, which means she must have had some pretty cold nights, but doesn't seem to have affected her in any way. She has had a couple of 14 mile runs behind the motor cycle without any sign of fatigue.
