The Whale Oil market is depressed owing to the absence of buyers, and this is principally caused by the low prices ruling for other produce which competes with Whale Oil

A parcel of No.1 Whale Oil was sold on this market on or about June 1st at £25 per ton. This oil was shipped from South Georgia per steamer "Anglesey". The owners at the time of arrival were determined to sell their produce, and the price named was the best obtainable under the circumstances.

Other sellers hold their stock for £35 per ton.

The bulk of the Whale Oil secured in the Antarctic during the season 1920/1921 has already arrived in Norway, and is being kept on board the Whaling Factories until market condition improve.

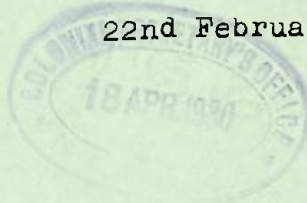
