

- With reference to our notice dated 30th August, regarding the importation of 15/20 Corriedale rams from South America in October next, I beg to inform you that in order to comply with "The Live Stock Regulations (Consolidation) 1923", Section XI, Subsection 3, it is proposed to land these animals on Tickle Island, Falkland Sound, where they will be quaratined for the necessary 90 days and dipped in accordance with Subsection 4 of the said section of the above regulations.
2. It is understood that s.s. "Lafonia" carrying these sheep will receive partique at Fox-Bay before proceeding to Tickle Island.
