Regarding the Eliza Cove stream, the work necessary to clear the course of the stream and to drain the ponds in the flat amounts to about 3000 yards, Mr Peterson is perpared to undertake this work for 6d per yard.

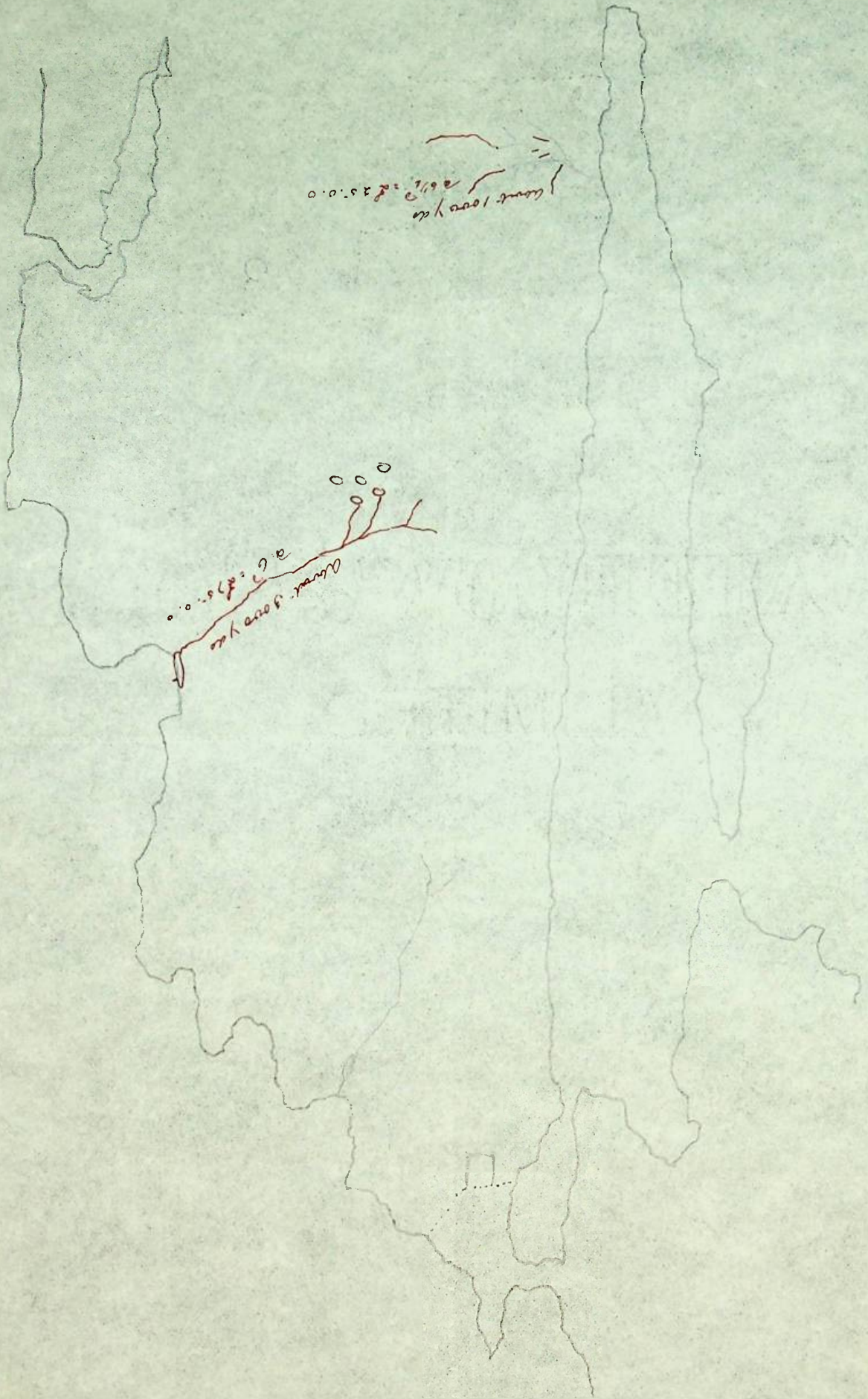

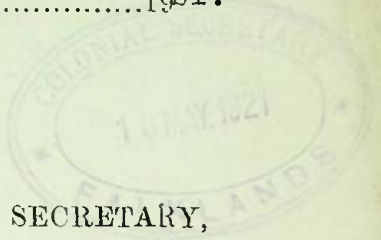
