Sir,

We the undersigned holders of grazing licences for horses on the cornon beg to enquire whether any steps may be taken to prevent the indiscriminate driving of our horses to the town. The animals are being continually herded from their feeding ground to the common fence as often as twenty times during the week, in many instances this being quite unnecessary. It then takes the horses at least two hours to return to their pasturage having to cross the rough stony area immediately outside the common fence. Under the present conditions any benefit the animals derive from grazing on the common is nullified by this continual driving around. In the absence of any regulations by the Colonial Government in this matter we would suggest that a small corral would undoubtedly be an asset and prove of no small benefit.
