

# Legislative Council

Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> April 1856

Present: -

His Excellency Governor Moore

The Honble Thomas Warwick Brooke

John Mathhem Jean Esquire

The Council met pursuant to summons.

The oaths were administered to all the Members and to the clerk. - The minutes of the last preceding meeting were read.

His Excellency the Governor then laid on the table the draft of an Ordinance to extend the Jury list of 1855 to the 10<sup>th</sup> of May 1856 and to provide for the formation of the "Jury list of 1856".

The Members of the Council having been in possession of a copy of the proposed Ordinance for some days His Excellency moved that this being a case of emergency the standing rules relative to the readings of an Ordinance be suspended and the several readings carried through at this sitting - Agreed to.

The Ordinance was then read three times and passed. -

The Council then adjourned sine die
