The minutes of the previous Council of 1st Dec. 1882 were read & confirmed.

Hon. C. de Meville Green took the oath & his seat at the Council.

His Excellency informed the Council that since their last meeting he had received a despatch from the Hon. the Secretary of State for the Colonies with reference to the Customs Ordinance No. 10 of 1882, & directing that "manufactured" tobacco be included with "Cut & Cigarettes" at $\frac{3}{4}$ per lb. instead of 2/.

His Excellency moved that the Standing Order be suspended & that the Amendment Ordinance which he now laid on the table be read a first time.
