

## OGILVIE FAMILY

*NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Any variations which may occur in the spellings of names are recorded as written in the records at the time.*

**John OGILVIE** was married to **Jessie SWANKIE** (*not in Falkland Islands*).

John, Jessie, four children & infant, were passengers on the *Ramses* departing England November 1888. Accompanying them was Jessie's sister **Georgina SWANKIE**. John came under contract to the Falkland Islands Company Ltd as a blacksmith.

Georgina departed for Sandy Point 24 June 1892 on board the *Denderah*.

## FIRST GENERATION

1. **David Niddrie OGILVIE** born 18 June 1877 in Arbroath, Scotland. Married **Jane (Jeannie) COX** (*not in Falkland Islands*). Jane was born 3 May 1885 in Dundee, Scotland. David was farm manager on Lively Island. David, age 46, Jane, age 38, and their two children, emigrated to Canada 25 August 1923, via Valparaiso per *Lagarto*, to join David's brother engaged in farming in Quesnel, Cariboo, British Columbia. [FIM Oct 1923]
2. **Isabella Gray OGILVIE** born in 1879 (*in Scotland?*) Isabella, living in Dundee, was married to **Theodore Marshall YEADON** of Leeds, Yorkshire, formerly of Patagonia & Falkland Islands, 20 October 1904 in St Paul's Episcopal Church, Dundee by the Rev Kenneth Mackenzie MA. [Xmas 1904]
3. **Henry "Harry" Maxwell OGILVIE** born in 1884 (*in Scotland?*) Commenced work for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd in Camp 12 June 1903 on £5.0.0 a month. Finished work 16 June 1904 and closed his FIC account with a cash order for £40.15.4. Arrived from Liverpool on board the *Orita* 7 June 1906. Commenced work for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd in Camp 16 July 1906 and went on contract from 13 September 1906 (*appears to be peat cutting and helping to erect the telephone line*). In May 1907 his passage from England of £14.0.0 was deducted from his FIC account. Harry finished work 17 August 1907 and closed his FIC account with a cash order for £51.5.11. Henry departed for Valparaiso on board the *Orissa* 30 August 1907.
4. **Arthur OGILVIE** born (*in Scotland?*) Commenced work for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd in the North Arm area 13 September 1898 on £4.0.0 per month. His wages increased to £4.10.0 a month from 1 August 1900. Arthur finished work 21 May 1901 and closed his FIC account with a cash order for £11.5.0.
5. **Georgina OGILVIE** born (*in Scotland?*)
6. **Sarah Preston OGILVIE** born 16 February 1890 in Stanley. Her father's occupation was recorded as blacksmith.
7. **Agnes Chaplin OGILVIE** born 24 July 1892. Her father's occupation was recorded as blacksmith.

## SECOND GENERATION

1. **Ethel Jane OGILVIE** born 17 May 1912 on Lively Island. Her father's occupation was recorded as farm manager. Ethel, age 1 day, died on Lively Island 18 May 1912 from premature birth and is buried there.
2. **Doris Yeadon OGILVIE** born 3 July 1913 on Lively Island and baptised 7 August 1913 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as manager. Doris, age 10, emigrated to Canada 25 August 1923, via Valparaiso per *Lagarto*, with her family. [FIM Oct 1923]
3. **Arthur Henry OGILVIE** born 18 December 1914 on Lively Island and baptised 14 December 1915 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as farm manager. Arthur, age 8, emigrated to Canada 25 August 1923, via Valparaiso per *Lagarto*, with her family. [FIM Oct 1923]
