2. His Excellency is informed that the boat has been used by the tenant of the Folkland Islands Company at Sea Lion Island, and that the boat is now at North Arm.

3. I am to say that the Governor will feel obliged if you will kindly arrange for the s.s. "Falkland" to bring the boat back to Stanley on her next trip to North Arm, should the boat be there, or, if not, to bring the boat back from Sea Lion Island if she is still there.
