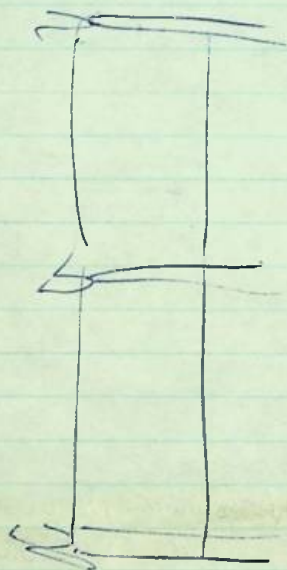

NOTES TO PERSONS WISHING TO IMPORT DOGS INTO THE FALKLAND
ISLANDS:

1. One copy of the Veterinary Certificate should accompany each dog on the voyage and another copy (for each dog) should be sent immediately to the Officer-in-Charge, Agricultural Department, Stanley, Falkland Islands.
2. A certificate of management of dogs during transportation must be signed by the Master or 1st Officer of the transporting vessel before the dog is allowed to disembark in the Falklands.
3. The dog will be subjected to 90 days quarantine unless the transporting vessel sailed direct from UK to the Falkland Islands; in which case the period of transport may be deducted from 90 days and the remaining time spent in quarantine in Stanley. A minimum period of 14 days House Quarantine may be required.
4. Any incidental expenses incurred on arrival or during the period of quarantine will be charged to the owner or importer.
5. The cost of quarantine and any veterinary or other charges incurred during the inspection and/or treatment of the dog will be charged to the owner or importer.

2. AS IN CHANDLER'S TELEX: WE ARE CONFUSED AS TO WHAT TO DO ABOUT CAGES. URGENT REPLY PLEASE. ALSO REGARDS COSTS OF SHIPMENT.

3. HAVE RECEIVED DARTMOOR PONY SOC STUD BOOK FROM CROWN AGENTS PLEASE THANK THEM.

4. IMPORTANT: PLEASE NOTE AND PLEASE INFORM CROWN AGENTS THAT THEY MUST REPEAT MUST APPLY FOR LICENSE TO IMPORT ALL ANIMALS. WHEN LICENSE IS ISSUED FROM HERE THEY WILL BE SENT CURRENT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS. IT IS NOT REPEAT NOT SUFFICIENT TO DUPLICATE OUT OF DATE CERTIFICATES. THE SITUATION PRESENTED TO ME HAS BEEN VERY AWKARD AND UNNECESSARY IF THE ESTABLISHED PROCEDURE WAS FOLLOWED CORRECTLY. A LICENSE IS ISSUED BY THE AGRICULTURAL DEPARTMENT, STANLEY ONLY WHEN SOMEONE HAS APPLIED FOR ONE. AT THE TIME WHEN A LICENSE TO IMPORT IS ISSUED THE RELEVANT CURRENT HEALTH CERTIFICATES ARE SUPPLIED.

OUR RE BS1/403998

FURTHER MY TELEX DETAILING SOME OF THE PROBLEMS FACED WITH MOVING HORSES TO FALKLANDS . I OMITTED TO MENTION THE FACT THAT NEARLY ALL VESSELS EX UK SAIL VIA ASCENCION ISLAND. MAFF TOLWORTH INDICATED VERBALLY EARLIER THIS YEAR THAT THEY WOULD NOT RECOMMEND ANY MOVEMENT VIA ASCENCION BUT WHEN I PUT THE QUESTION AGAIN FORMALLY TODAY TO MR JOHN WILLIAMS AT TOLWORTH.

HE STATED THAT THE DECISION RESTS ENTIRELY WITH THE FALKLAND GOVERNMENT. MAFF CANNOT OFFER ANY ADVISE TO US BUT SUGGEST THAT IF YOU REQUIRE ANY ADVICE ON STATUS OF ASCENCION THEY WILL RESPOND TO YOU.

COULD YOU THEREFORE CONSIDER, CONSULT AND ADVISE US YOUR OPINION AS TO WHETHER WE CAN SHIP VIA ASCENCION.

IF THIS COURSE IS FOLLOWED THE HORSES WOULD REMAIN ON VESSEL BUT EXTENSIVE MOVEMENT OF PERSONNEL TO AND FROM VESSEL WOULD OCCUR MAKING QUARANTEN IMPOSSIBLE. VESSELS SOMETIMES LAY AT ANCHOR FOR SOME DAYS WITHOUT BENEFIT OF BREEZES. HORSES WILL BE ON DECK AND REQUIRE CONSTANT WASHING DOWN.

REGRET TO SAY THAT PROSPECTS OF EASY SOLUTION TO THIS SHIPMENT NOT YET VISIBLE - ALTHOUGH EXPERIENCE HAS SHOWN THAT THESE THINGS OFTEN FIT INTO PLACE - SO WE HAVE NOT GIVEN UP HOPE.

EXPORT TO FALKLANDS OF HORSES FROM GB

CROWN AGENTS PHONED ME ON 1 DEC 83 TO ASK WHETHER WE WOULD ALLOW HORSES FOR FALKLANDS TO BE TRANSSHIPPED AT ASCENSION. I EXPLAINED THAT DECISION WAS FOR FALKLANDS' VETERINARY AUTHORITIES, THOUGH WE WOULD ADVISE IF ASKED.

I DID NOT, REPEAT NOT, MAKE ANY RECOMMENDATION. MY COLLEAGUE RESPONSIBLE FOR EXPORT WELFARE IS SATISFIED THERE ARE NO WELFARE IMPLICATIONS TO A STOP-OVER ON ASCENSION, PROVIDED ADEQUATE FACILITIES EXIST.

WE DO NOT KNOW IF THERE ARE RESIDENT HORSES ON ASCENSION- MIGHT MILITARY BE ABLE TO HELP?. OIR, IF SO, WHAT THEIR DISEASE STATUS IS. THE ORIGIN OF ANY MIGHT GIVE GOOD GUIDE TO THE DISEASE RISK THEY PRESENT TO HORSES IN TRANSIT BETWEEN GB AND FALKLANDS. FOR GUIDANCE, AFRICA AND SOUTH AMERICA (NORTH OF R.AMAZON) PLUS PERU AND BOLIVIA ARE PROHIBITED AREAS FOR IMPORTATION INTO GB.

IF WE CAN HELP FURTHER, PLEASE CONTACT AGAIN.

GENERAL MILLS HAS ASKED THAT I EXPLAIN FURTHER TO YOU SOME OF THE DIFFICULTIES WE FACE IN ATTEMPTING TO ARRANGE SHIPMENT OF 17 HORSES.

AAA IDEALLY WE WOULD HAVE LIKED TO HAVE SHIPPED THESE 17 HORSES (PLUS A FURTHER 5 OR 6 FOR FIC) ON DINA KHALAF AS THEY WERE AVAILABLE AT THE TIME AND NO EXTRA FREIGHT WOULD HAVE BEEN CHARGED. HOWEVER DINA KHALAF COULD NOT ACCOMMODATE ANY ADDITIONAL CATTLE/ SHEEP IF ANY HAD BEEN AVAILABLE).

BBB YOU WILL APPRECIATE ANOTHER SPECIALIST ANIMAL CARRIER CANNOT BE CHARTERED TO CARRY JUST THESE HORSES. DINA KHALAF COST POUNDS 108 THOUSAND. WE NOW HAVE TO LOOK AT POSITIONING HORSES ON DECK ON GENERAL CARGO VESSELS.

CCC CARRIAGE OF HORSES BY SEA ACTS OF PARLIAMENT STRICTLY ENFORCED BY MAFF DICTATE THAT HORSES CANNOT BE SHIPPED OUT OF BRITAIN ON DECK BETWEEN MONTHS OF OCTOBER AND MARCH UNLESS VESSEL IS OF 4000 TONNES WITH 10 FOOT FREEBOARD. THIS SEVERELY RESTRICTS NUMBER OF VESSEL SAILINGS THAT CAN BE CONSIDERED. MOST VESSELS ARE WELL UNDER THIS TONNAGE. IF A RO-RO VESSEL WAS PROGRAMMED WE COULD CONSIDER PUTTING HORSES UNDER DECK AS WITH DOGS AND SAND SHORE.

DDD HORSES WILL REQUIRE HANDLERS WITH VETERINARY KNOWLEDGE AND MESSRS JOSS AND MASON WOULD BE WILLING TO CONSIDER THIS FURTHER TASK. THEY BOTH AGREE WITH COMMERCIAL OPINION OF LEP BLOODSTOCK THAT TWO HANDLERS WOULD BE ABLE TO COPE WITH SUCH A TASK. Dear Steve,

First I should like to apologise for not writing to you earlier and for the number of telexes which we exchanged, many of which were unfortunately liable to misinterpretation. The trouble was that whenever I had a letter drafted for typing (Lynda Glennie comes in only twice a week) the situation changed so drastically as to make nonsense of the draft!

I hope that you have by now recovered from your exhaustion! It must have been a very tiring business getting the animals off the DINA KHALAF and away to their widely scattered farms. However to have achieved it by 14th November was no mean feat - congratulations!

I know that you have had a long and detailed telex from George Warrick about the difficulties facing him over finding a suitable ship to carry the remaining horses, ponies and dogs. The problem facing us now is that we have had to buy the horses and ponies and the deadline of 31st January could leave us with them on our hands together with the bills for keep. The cost of keep was negligible until they had to be brought in from grazing and have stabling provided for them for the winter.

As I think you know we had hoped to get the horses away in the ANDALUCIA STAR about the middle of this month but the MOD mounted a team of 17 at what George Warrick thought was to be the final meeting to tie up the details. I was not at the meeting but I am sure that the MOD had no intention whatever of allowing the horses to be carried on board that ship. They might have said so earlier and saved everybody from wasting their time. Our hopes are now pinned on the SAND SHORE which Roland Dowling tells us is due to leave Stanley on 2nd January and might be expected to leave Marshwood early in February. However we have not

/ yet

yet had confirmation that this is so or that space will be available as it was for the dogs. I do hope that those who are expecting horses will relent when they hear of the problems facing us.

The expense of the exercise has been truly frightening. Some bills are still to come in including those for the return trip for Joss, Mason, Dowling and Eastwood. A brief resume of these costs is enclosed.

I wrote to Julian Chandler suggesting that the payments agreed by farmers for animals they ordered should be sent to us so that they can earn interest. I would also be able to set them off against the expenditure in my accounts with a view to keeping the overall cost so far down to £170,000 leaving £30,000 to cover the remaining animals and the 30 Ayrshire heifers for Malcolm Ashworth if he finally decides to re-establish the dairy farm.

I understand that your contract terminates on 31st December but I hope that your successor will be prepared to carry on the good work of your 'Noah's Ark'. What are your future movements likely to be? If you come back to UK I hope that you will come to see us and have a long chat!

The veterinary report by Joss and Mason is now in its final form - sanitised to protect us all from brickbats from animal protection societies who criticised us for 'sending 220 poor animals in a ship more suited to an ornamental lake than the rigours of the South Atlantic.' It had even been suggested that 50% would die on the way. In fact the voyage seems to have been a remarkable success. It would be interesting to know how Jozannah managed her high jump feat - has she settled down in her new home?

I must pay tribute to Angela Lee, George Warrick and Tony Smith of the Crown Agents without whose help we would not have been able to begin, and also to Tim Harris of EXPORC, and James MacEwan of LEP (Bloodstock). I had no idea of the complexity of shipping animals overseas but have found it all most interesting.

This will reach you too late for Christmas but I hope you had a happy one and that 1984 will prove to be a prosperous year for you.



Thankyou for your letters of 16 December and 10 January to Steve Whitley. I'm sorry I have not replied earlier but I've been endeavouring to sort out the problem of the time limit on the dispatch of horses, from this end. - Numerous schemes & telephone calls to Crown Agents. You will have heard by now from Sir Rex Hunt of the decision of the local committee of the Falklands Appeal!

I had started this letter last week but then your latest telex arrived and threw things into confusion. No I didn't know that the dogs were coming on the M.V. Singularity via Las Palmas and Ascension Island only the date. I've telexed George Warrick asking that the dogs be sent direct preferably by the A.E.S I've also asked about the Spaniel dog and Dachshund dog or bitch which were asked for. Perhaps they could be sent on the next sailing of the A.E.S.

As Julian Chandler left at Christmas I haven't been able to find out about the local finances but I'll answer your question from your letter of the 10th as best I can. (Steve left some notes).

- (1) Ayrshire bulls. Dobbys declined a bull and it was passed onto Claude Mulkenbuhr with the approval of the appeal here (Julian Chandler).
- (2) It is a female calf.
- (4) All information on prices came from the Falkland Islands Appeal in London.
- (5) This is a misprint.
- (6) These prices arrived too late for Steve to get full repayment but owners were charged at the rate of £7 per budgie and £30 per cat plus noraml charges for food etc. So most has been recompd. Again the local appeal has always been kept informed.
