I bed to submit that approval be given to allow the Government sanitary horse to graze in the Guarantine Station paddock. At present there is a horse and some sheep belonging to Ir. Mutchinson grazing there.

- 2. The meddock used by the Government sanitary horse is now being used for the transport of rock for the sea well. The quarry is just to the south of this peddock and there is a danger of falling stones hitting the horse. The gate is left oren during the day, the horse strays and complaints have been made by people in the vicinity that the horse has been eating boxwood etc. over the garden fences.
- 5. There is a smaller Government paddock to the Eouth and on the hill, but this is too exposed in the minter and there is no shelter there.
