I am directed by His Honour the Chief Justice to transmit to you the undermentioned remarks made by the Registrar concerning the Dip at Pebble Is.W.F., and to request that you will kindly direct the Chief Inspector of Stock to furnish a Report concerning same:-

Extract from Minute dated 3rd February 1921 in S.C.No. 1 of 1921.

3.PLANT The value of the Sheep Dip and draining stage(Pebble Is) is put in at £30 and that for Keppel Is at £10. If the Dips are only worth the figures stated then they must be practically useless for carrying out the dipping required by law (Ordinance 6 of 1901). The Dip at Pebble Is, if efficient for the work for which it is intended, should be worth at least £150 x x x
