I spoke to you about this. At present the Govt. motor mechanic is the only person competent to overhaul and repair motor vehicles and in consequence frequent applications are made for his services. You I think suggest charging $1/9$ per hour with double rate for overtime work plus actual cost of any materials used.

2. There might be some difficulty in charging per hour. It would probably be preferable to charge per job based on the estimated time and work required. The motor mechanic would examine the job and

furnish an estimate of its cost, taking into consideration his time and that of the apprentice. In other countries the charge is made per job and not by the hour.

2. The Motor Mechanic would require to submit to you the name of the apprentice, the work required and an estimate of the cost.

3. I understood there is a charge of 5/- for putting cars over the pit for underneath cleaning or examination. A further charge will have to be made for cleaning re.
