Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that at a meeting held yesterday it was decided to form a society to be known as "The Stanley Folk Dancing Society". His Excellency the Governor was made the President of the Society, His Excellency having previously intimated that he would be willing to have his name associated with the movement. Nearly forty members were enrolled at this first meeting, and a Committee was formed of which I am the Chairman.

It is proposed that the Society shall meet once a week during the winter, from (say) 8 to 9.30 p.m., in order to learn and practise traditional dances. I should be glad to know if it would be possible to have the use of the new gymnasium for the purpose, and, if so, I would request that as the work is largely educational the charge should be made as low as possible.
