I have the honour to acquaint you that it is usual for me to request H.M. Ships to provide parties of men for the purposes of visiting the guns at Sappers Hill and Mount Lowe to do anything necessary for their preservation.

2. I have done this in the case of H.M.S. Dartmouth but am informed that a guide is necessary.

3. As I have no one at this Station whom I can spare to do this, or who has any knowledge of the exact position of the gun at Mount Lowe, I submit that it would be of great assistance if, on "Dartmouth's" return, a guide could be allotted to "Dartmouth" suitable to ~~latter~~ <sup>accompanying & directing</sup> for sending her men. I request I may be informed what arrangements can be made in time for me to communicate anything necessary immediately on her return. I can direct "Dartmouth's" party to Sappers Hill myself.
