Certificate of service.

Dr. H.M.S. Turner was appointed a Lieutenant in the Falkland Islands Volunteer Corps as from 5th May 1909.

Lieutenant H.M.S. Turner was gazetted as Major in the Corps with effect from 5th August 1914.

Major H.M.S. Turner ceased to be a Member of the Falkland Islands Volunteer Force as from 9th April 1915 on relinquishing the command.

The above statements of service are correct extracts from the Falkland Islands Gazette, no proper Corps records having been preserved.
