while the matter does not arise immediately it is relevant to the above proposals; I refer to the A.C.I. whereby all Second Lieutenants are, subject to satisfactory service, automatically made Lieutenants after six months service, which proceedure is of course followed by the Imperial Troops now in the Colony. Perhaps His Excellency would be kind enough to express an opinion on this at the same time.
