# A Record of Events

The first Local Bisley was held on the Old Range in 1928, on the 10th and 11th of March. Open sights were used throughout and the programme consisted of the following competitions in which 54 marksmen took part. His Excellency's Cup "King's Prize" in three stages. 1. 2, Rabid. Recruits' match. 3, Colonial Secretary's Cup. 4. Team Shcot. 5. Open Handicap. 6. Bishop's Trophy. 7. The 1929 meeting was the forerunner of Local Bisley as we know it today. The New Range was in use and some of the 44 competitors had "packed" rifles with aperture backsights. The fellowing extract from the "Penguin" of 27th February, 1929, is interesting.

"His Excellency the Governor, Arnold Hodson Esquire, C.M.G., who is an excellent shot and has taken such a keen interest in rifle shooting since his arrival in the Colony, was present throughout the meeting and took part in all events. The meeting was conducted on the lines of the Annual Bisley Meeting which is held in England. The new range admirably laid out by Mr. Roberts with modern targets, telephones and other conveniences presented a workmanlike appearance. Flags of all shapes and colours added gaiety to the surroundings and tended to connteract the depressing affects of the bitter gale which was blowing accompanied at times by squalls of rain. Tents and a large marquee had been erected for the convenience of the shooters, and gave a homelike appearance to the bleak moorlands."

Since then Local Bisley has been held annually except for a break of four years during the Second World War. Sometimes, as in 1929, the weather has behaved badly; the 1935 meeting took 9 weeks to complete owing to bad weather.

Three targets were in use in 1929 and the dimensions at the various ranges were -

On 30th March, 1934, the Bulls Eye at 200 yards was increased to 6", that at 300 yards to 9" and at 500/600 yards to 18" but they were reduced to the 1929 size on 1st February, 1936.

The aiming mark on the 500/600 yard targets has been increased to 30 inches and the magpie at 900/1000 yards has been made 72" round instead of square. The number of target frames on the New Range was increased to five and used for the first time at Local Bisley, 16th February, 1946. The Old Range was finally abandoned on this date.

The 900 and 1000 yard ranges were abandoned in 1952 because of the difficulty in striking reasonable weather for long range shooting. Competitions previously shot off at these ranges are now decided at 600 and 700 yards at targets similar in shape and colour to those used at the longer ranges. The new targets have the following dimensions.
