Articles of Agreement made and entered into the thirtieth day of November One thousand eight hundred and eighty two, between Bradford Wilmer of Stanley in the Falkland Islands of the one part, and the Colonial Secretary in behalf of the Government of the Falkland Islands of the other part.

Whereby it is mutually agreed between the said parties as follows

1. The said Bradford Wilmer for the consideration hereinafter mentioned agrees to become a constable in the Police Force of the Government of the Falkland Islands, and to act in all respects according to the directions and instructions given to him by the Government of the Falkland Islands through its properly qualified Officers and the said Bradford Wilmer hereby agrees that he will faithfully and honestly fulfil the duties required of him by or on behalf of the said Government of the Falkland Islands for the term of one year from the date of this agreement.

2. And it is hereby further agreed that in consideration of the services so to be rendered to the said Government of the Falkland Islands by the said Bradford Wilmer, the said Government of the Falkland Islands shall pay the said Bradford Wilmer the annual sum of Sixty pounds in monthly payments £5.0.0 of Five pounds, such pay to commence and begin from the date of the said Bradford Wilmer entering on his duties as constable.

3. And it is further agreed that the Government of the Falkland Islands will provide the said Bradford

Bradford Wilmer with quarters and garden free of charge to him, and allow himself to supply himself with sufficient Peat gratuitously from Crown Lands for the purpose of Fuel.

4. And it is further agreed that provided the Government shall employ the said Bradford Wilmer on the Public Works or in any manner not included in his duties duties as a Police Constable or in Customs or Police duties either on the harbour or on shore.. he shall be paid for such extra services at the rate of four shillings a day. 4/

Articles of Agreement made and entered into the first day of December, one thousand eight hundred and eighty five between Lawrence Newing of Stanley in the Falkland Islands of the one part, and His Excellency Thomas Kerr Governor and Commander-in Chief of the Falkland Islands on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen of the other part

Whereby it is mutually agreed between the said parties as follows.

1. The said Lawrence Newing for the consideration hereinafter mentioned agrees to become a Constable in the Police Force of the Government of the Falkland Islands, and to act in all respects according to the directions and instructions given to him by the Government of the Falkland Islands through its properly qualified Officers, and the said Lawrence Newing hereby agrees that he will faithfully and honestly fulfil the duties required of him by or on behalf of the said Government of the Falkland Islands for the term of one year from the date of this agreement.

2. And it is hereby further agreed that in consideration of the services so to be rendered by the said Lawrence Newing, the said Government

Government of the Falkland Islands shall pay the said Lawrence Newing the annual sum of sixty pounds, in £60 monthly payments of Five pounds, such £5 pay to commence and begin from the date of the said Lawrence Newing entering on his duties as Constable.

3. And it is further agreed that the Government of the Falkland Islands will provide the said Lawrence Newing with quarters and garden free of charge to him, and allow him to supply himself with sufficient peat gratuitously from Crown Lands for the purpose of Fuel

4. And it is further agreed that provided the Government shall employ the said Lawrence Newing on the public works or in any manner not included in his duties as a Police Constable or in the Customs, or Police duties either in the harbour or on shore he shall be paid for such extra services at the rate of four shillings a day - ^s 4/-
