It is understood that the Treaty of Peace has been presented by the Allies to the German Government for acceptance by Monday the 23rd June.

Should the German Government accept and sign the terms of Peace, the People of the Falkland Islands are invited not to indulge in any premature celebrations of Peace.

In the event of the terms of Peace being accepted by Germany the days on which a public celebration would more fittingly take place in this Colony will be made known at a later date.
