BY THE KING A PROCLAMATION.

GEORGE R. I.

WHEREAS A DEFINITIVE TREATY OF PEACE BETWEEN
US AND THE ASSOCIATED GOVERNMENTS AND THE GERMAN
GOVERNMENT WAS CONCLUDED AT VERSAILLES ON THE 28TH
DAY OF JUNE LAST: IN CONFORMITY THEREUNTO WE HAVE
THOUGHT FIT HEREBY TO COMMAND THAT THE SAME BE PUBLISHED
IN DUE COURSE THROUGHOUT ALL OUR DOMINIONS: AND WE
DO DECLARE TO ALL OUR LOVING SUBJECTS OUR WILL AND
PLEASURE THAT UPON THE EXCHANGE OF THE RATIFICATION
THEREOF THE SAID THE ATY OF PEACE BE OBSERVED INVIOLABLY
AS WELL BY SEA AS BY LAND AND IN ALL PLACES WHATSOEVER:
STRICTLY CHARGING AND COMMANDING ALL OUR LOVING SUBJECTS
TO TAKE NOTICE HEREOF AND TO COMFORM THEMSELVES
THEREUNTO ACCORDINGLY.
