Sir,

At the request of the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, I have the honour to transmit to you the accompanying supply of forms for use by the Registrar of the Prize Court for the half-yearly return of cases adjudged in Prize Courts, required to be made by Section 12 of the Naval Prize Act, 1864, which reads as follows:-


"12. The Registrar of every Vice-Admiralty Prize Court shall, on the first day of January and first day of July in every year, make out a return (in such form as the Lords of the Admiralty from time to time direct) of all cases adjudged in the Court since the last half-yearly return, and shall with all convenient speed send the same to the Registrar of the High Court of Admiralty, who shall keep the same in the Registry of that Court, and who shall, as soon as conveniently may be, send a copy of the returns of each year to the Lords of the Admiralty, who shall lay the same before both Houses of Parliament".

2. It is requested that the returns be prepared and forwarded to me in quadruplicate inclusive of the copies intended for the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty and the Admiralty Registry; that the first returns sent in may include all the cases which have been dealt with in each Prize Court up to the 31st December 1940; and that nil returns be rendered where no proceedings have been taken during the period under review.

Summary of proceeding regarding the Greek ship  
CORINTHIAKOS.

1940.  
Nov. 27th

This ship was reported by the Ministry of Shipping  
as intending to call at Stanley for bunkers.

She arrived on December, 20th.

On the same day a report of her manifest was  
telegraphed to the Secretary of State for the Colonies  
following his request.

It consisted of hides, leather and wool.

Dec. 27th.

Reply to this telegram ordered that 2,041 tons of  
hides and 105 tons of leather shipped by Ketelohn and  
Mbos, two firms in the War Trade list, should be unloaded  
and seized in prize. Before unloading could be done  
this was followed by orders not to unload but to detain  
ship.

Jan. 18th

A writ was issued and served on the 19th and a sitting  
of a Prize Court fixed for February 18th.

Feb. 14th.

On this date the Secretary of State for the Colonies  
telegraphed that Corinthiakos and her cargo should be  
released and this was done on February 15th.

There was therefore no sitting of the Prize Court  
on Corinthiakos.

Feb. 15th.

Application for discontinuance of proceedings was  
filed, and granted by the Judge on this date.
