

Captain Øre of the Whale Factory "Ronald" informed me that he had three gas cylinders on board which had been in service at ACCEPTED Deception Island South Shetlands.

He asked that the Comman Agents be instructed to have three charged cylinders sent to the ship's Agents in Cardiff early in September next, so that the "Ronald" could bring them out for next season.

Captain Øre stated that he would land the three used cylinders at the first English Port of call, but was of the opinion that it would not be until September at Cardiff.
