ORAKE PASSAGE bounded on the north by the latitude of Cape Horn, on the east by the meridian of 55° V. long., and on the south by the South Shetland Islands.

WEDDELL BEA is bounded by a line joining the northeastern extremity of Coats Land to Joinville Island.
