I have taken a look at the new B.A.T. stamp issue on Conservation which illustrates different species of penguin.

I do not feel qualified to comment on two of the drawings, namely of the Emperor and Adelie penguins. I would however like to mention one or two points about the illustration of the Macaroni.

The colour of the crest is correct but feel the shape and positioning is wrong. In an effort to illustrate this point and to help the artist I have enclosed a small sketch.

The bill colouration and form could also be altered to show a much deeper shape and colour. In my rough drawing I have also brought attention to the "pink facial strip" This is quite a distinct feature of the birds bill and even which such a small reduction in the finished stamp I would think it might show.

Thank you for your letter of 17th July / As regards the artwork for the Penguins Issue, we have the following comments, based on a viewing of the drawings by Ian Strange.

The colour of the crest of the lacaroni Penguin is correct but Mr. Strange feels the shape and position is wrong. He has kindly provided the attached sketch which should prove helpful. In particular the bill colouration and form could be altered to show a much deeper shade and colour and there is a "pink facial strip" which is quite a distinct feature of the bird's bill, which would show up even when the drawing is reduced to stamp size.

The only other comment we have concerns the background in the inset drawing for the Macaroni, Adelie and Gentoo penguins. We are not sure that this properly shows the type of terrain to be found in the Antarctic and I would suggest that these drawings should be shown to Mr. Stonehouse for his expert opinion.



I refer to your letter of 12 July, ref H1/BAT 4/34942 and return the four finished designs.

2. In case you wish to consider the views of Mr Ian Strange, he has commented as follows:-

"It would be wrong for me to comment on some of the species shown for I am not familiar with them. However, the Macaroni penguin I consider shows up as being the least accurate, but considering the final reduction in size, I would personally not advise the artist to attempt to correct the errors. The crest and bill of the birds are not quite right."

You will note that although there seems to be some slight reservation about the accuracy, particularly of the Macaroni penguin, Mr Strange does not recommend that an attempt be made to remedy the situation.

3. It has also been pointed out that the bills of the Gentoo Adelie and Macaroni penguins are not quite accurate, i.e. the Gentoo's bill is too pointed and the Adelie's and Macaroni's too hooked. To make assurance doubly sure will you kindly obtain the views of Dr R M Laws of BAS, Cambridge, on our behalf.

4. As regards the release of the issue, this should if possible be released as soon as possible during the forthcoming season and, again, it would be helpful if you would kindly liaise with British Antarctic Survey (BAS) Cambridge, about movement of ships to get the stamps to the Bases.

5. I will let you know as soon as possible what we think the values for these stamps should be.

6. Doubtless you have taken into account the views of Mr Stonehouse.

Can I combine an answer to your two letters P&T/2/31 and 51 since the subjects overlap.

The reason for the popularity of the BAT Penguins issue is that it has been taken up by one of the big American first day cover sellers. This I think points up your whole problem. You can either issue the sort of stamps which are wanted by the stamp buyer or those which are wanted by philatelists. There is a vast difference between the two.

The stamp buyers are an increasing market and consist, in a large number, of people who buy interesting souvenirs which are pressed upon them by attractive advertisements appealing to other interests, wildlife, flowers etc. etc. The stamps are sold as incidental to these interests, to people who don't know a tete-beche from a bisect. The philatelists, who band themselves into insular little groups, are far more vociferous, usually because the members have contacts in the countries concerned and can through them cause problems to the Administdration. I think part of the problem with philatelists is that the day of the classic stamp is always in the past and their only hope for the future is the rare variety. The souvenir collector on the other hand wants a well designed and printed stamp on an expensive looking cover with a clear cancellation mark, of perhaps an attractive souvenir sheet which adds to his collection of memorabilia on his favourite theme. To him an APS black blot means nothing and there is no evidence that it has ever deterred anyone from buying a set of stamps.

So you see the desires of the two parties can rarely be reconciled except by unsatisfactory compromise. In general Mr Sim's advice still holds good but in your case it would appear wisest to keep to the lower figure of the souvenir sheet per year and the Rowland Hill issue represents the best marketing opportunity in 1970. I hope that this rather rambling letter is of some help. In the meantime I am going ahead with the designs for the Rowland Hill set, including a souvenir sheet using the 33p value.






