Sir

I have the honour to report progress as follows. on the whaling in this Dependency:-.

The season has been normal as far as whales appeared, but owing to the almost entire absence of summer the catch is far from satisfactory.

In the absence of gales, snow & fog with very dull weather prevailed, thus rendering the hunting difficult & poor. There has been no whales in the far south, I did not see one in a direct course of 150 miles SWS or return of 100 miles N & N.E. The bad coals supplied to the factories will cause them to leave earlier than they otherwise would.

The catch in round numbers to date is:-

Thor I 19.000. Solstraf 20500. Orn 12.000

Bombay 12.000. Svend Foyn I 12.600. Neko 12.000

with the results shown:


"Solstreif"	21,000	Barrels.

2. I also understand that the following accidents
have taken place in the South Shetlands:-

Cunner of the Whale Catcher "Hanka" belonging
to the floating factory "Neko" lost overboard.
Explosion of boiler on one of the ~~factories~~
caused the death of one seaman.

3. I understand that the "Thor 1" will arrive to-morrow
morning and that the remainder of the whaling fleet may be
expected between the 1st and 20th of next month.
