Sir,

With reference to Mr Condon's letter No 489/17 of the 29th April, 1918, I am directed by the Governor to forward to you herewith Whaling Returns (Form S.M.(N.P.) 432) furnished by the whaling factories "Solstroff", "Orn II", "Bombay", "Thor I", and "Svend Foyn I", detailing the catches made by those vessels in the waters of the South Shetlands and Graham's Land during the 1918-19 whaling season.

3. The only other vessel operating in the waters of this Dependency, the "Neko", proceeded from the South Shetlands to South Georgia. The returns made by this vessel will doubtless be transmitted to me in due course by the Stipendiary Magistrate, South Georgia, when they will be forwarded to you.
