Mr. Treasurer

All pp. I have dealing with the landing certificates ¹⁹²¹⁻²² are attached (i.e. those from the South Holland fleet). Have you received any others?

The Southern Whaling Company herein asks that a simple adjustment be made in respect of the quantity of the oil and of the refunds to be made. As you point out in Wp. 329/22 the refunds apply to separate accounts and have to be recorded separately by us. It would however be a convenience if a simple letter could be sent to the Board Agents covering statements drawn up in the Treasury in respect of each company, showing in detail the amounts of the refunds.

According to the enclosed Landing Certificates, the actual quantity of oil discharged ex s.s. "Svend Foyn I" was 25,980.25 bbls, making an excess over declaration of 480.25 bbls, which at 5/s per bbl, amounts to £120. 1. 3d; which plus the remittance charge at 1%, of £24/s, make the total amount to be collected, amount to £121.5.3d, viz:-

Landed at Pensacola.....929,466 gal's.

-do- Norway.....109,744 -do-

Total...1,039,210 gallons. or

25,980.25 bbls.

2. On the Landing Certificate "A" from Pensacola, it is stated that 9.35 lbs are equal to One gallon, whereas I have always understood that 9.25 lbs are equal to one gallon, and that 2.2 lbs are equal to One Kilogram, and my calculations are based thereon.

3. All the Landing Certificates so far received have been sent into you by me, and I have no others.

4. I am at present awaiting a reply to my minute of 2/10/22 as to "The Average Market Price" mentioned in s:3 of Ordinance No. 4 of 1922. in order that I may be in a position to report as to the amount of export duty to be refunded please.

Sir,

We beg to hand you enclosed Certificates of Landing of the cargo of Whale Oil produced by the floating factory "Svend Foyn I" 1921/22. The returns show that the bulk of the cargo, viz: 919525 gallons was discharged at Pensacola, while the balance, 108,570 gallons was discharged at Kjøbmandsskjær, Norway.

The oil delivered at Pensacola was sold on the basis of £.32.- a ton for No. 0/1, naked. The oil discharged in Norway has been sold at an average price of 55 oere a kilo - equal to £. 21-10-0 a ton at the exchange of 26/-. The average price obtained for No. 0/1 oil is consequently less than £.40.- a ton and the export duty is, therefore, to be charged with 3/6 d. a barrel whereas we have paid 5/-. When informing the Crown Agents for the Colonies of the actual number of barrels of oil discharged we shall be much obliged if you simultaneously instructed them to pay us the difference in our favour.

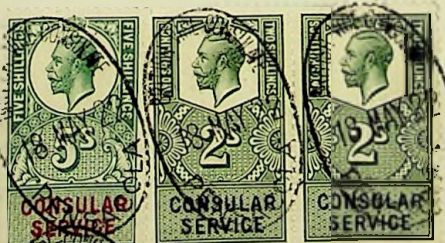

Gentlemen,

I am directed by the Governor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 25th of August, transmitting certificates of landing of the whale oil ex "Svend Foyn I" for the season 1921-22.

2. The number of gallons landed at Pensacola was as shown by the landing certificate 929,466 while 109,744 were landed in Norway. The total was therefore 1,039,210 gallons or 25,980.25 barrels. The actual excess of oil over the quantity declared locally and on which duty has been paid at the rate of 5s. 0d per barrel, is 480.25 barrels. The sum of £120. 1s. 3d is therefore owing from you as duty together with the remittance charge of 1% making a total of £121. 5s. 3d. A refund of part of the duty will be made in due course when the above sum will be taken into account.

3. You will observe that the figures in the preceding paragraph relating to the actual quantity of oil landed differ from the reckoning as shown in the landing certificates. The invariable rule in converting to English measures the quantity of oil for duty is to take 2.2 lbs as equal to one kilogram and 9.25 lbs (not 9.35) as equivalent to one gallon, with 40 gallons to the barrel.
