

I beg to submit the attached Landing Certificate of oil discharged ex s.s. "Thor I", from which it would appear that 599.35 bbls were landed in excess of that declared to on Export Bill of Entry No. 88 of 1922, which at 5/s per bbl, amounts to £149. 15/s, and plus remittance charge at 1%, (30/s), makes the total sum of £ 151. 5/s to be collected by the Crown Agents. viz:- 3,731,760 lbs; equal to 943,974 galls: or 23,599.35 bbls.

2. On the attached landing certificate it is stated that 9.35 lbs are equal to One Gallon, whereas I have always understood that 9.25 lbs are equal to one gallon, and that 2.2 lbs are equal to One Kilo.


