
I have the honour to inform you that the Nor Whaling Company, Owners of the Whaling Factory "Orn II", have made arrangements to pay the Customs Export Duty on my catch of whale oil to the Crown Agents for the Colonies in London.

2. The estimated catch is 25,500 barrels, which at 5s/- per barrel, makes the total amount of duty payable £6,375. The Owners will also pay to the Crown Agents remittance charge of 1% on the above amount, viz. £63: 15s: Od, making a grand total of £6,438: 15s: Od.
