



- (1) If you are attacked it is essential in reporting the fact to give your position, course and speedxx so that help may be sent as soon as nossible. Subsequent alterations of course and speed should also be signalled.
- (2) A case recently occurred when a convoy scattered because one ship signalled she was tornedoed when an escorting Destroyer dropped a depth charge. When a depth charge is dropped one or more shocks will be felt but there is no danger. The explosion gives the impression that the ship has struck a submerged object.
- (3) On all occasions of a route being given to a master of a British merchant vessel they should remind him that if photographs, however indistinct, of hostile or suspicious vessels are obtained they are of great value to the Admiralty and should be handed over to the Naval Authorities at the ship's first port of call together with a short account of the circumstances under which they were taken.
