This Memorandum has been approved by the Norwegian Government.

Memorandum of general conditions governing supply of a detachment of volunteers from the Norwegian Military Forces for service in the felkland Islands including South Georgia.

The Morwagian Government undertake to despatch a detachment of volunteers from the Morwagian military forces in the United Zingdom for military service in South Georgia consisting of

1 Officer 1 Sergeent 3 N.C.Os. 9 Other Ranks (including Cook).

The Norwegian Government will bear the cost of all pay and allowances (which will be at normal Norwegian rates of pay and allowances). Further, the Norwegian Covernment will repay to the United Hingdom Government a sum representing the amount which this personnel would have don't by way of maintenance if they had remained in the United Kingdom (excepting daily if they had remained in the United Kingdom (excepting daily rations, which will be provided and paid for by the Falkland Islands Government).

The United Lingdom Government will be responsible for bearing the cost of passage of these men to MITTVINAN and back and also cost of maintenance from the date when they leave this country. Maintenance will include any special items of equipment which will be necessary.

The Norwegian Covernment undertake to bear the sost of any non-creative benefits arising in respect of these men, including any compensation or ponsions granted to any of these men or their dependents, arising of ther from energy action or accident.

5. visololine.

By the Allied Forces (Application of Acts to Colonies, &c.) (No.1) Order, 1941 (Statutory Rule and Order No.155 of 1941) the appropriate provisions of the Allied Forces Act concerning the Allied Forces in the United Mingdow have been made applicable, Allied Forces and the United Mingdow have been made applicable, With adaptations and modifications to Colonies including the Falkland Islands and its dependencies.

Such provisions empower the Norwegian military courts and authorities to exercise within the territory in relation to members of the Norwegian military forces in matters concerning discipline and internal administration all such powers as are conferred upon them by the law of Morway.

If any offence of murder, manslaughter or rape is alleged to have been committed by a member of this force the case shall be tried only by a givil Court of the territory.

In the event of a Norwegian Service Court passing a sentence of death on a member of the Morwegian Force the sentence will not be carried out until the appropriate Eritish Authority in the United Kingdom has signified concurrence but will be reported by the Norwegian Commander to the Officer Will be reported by the Norwegian Commander to the Officer Commanding (British) Troops Falkland Islands under whose command the forces are operating, who will report the circumstances through the Governor and the Colonial Office, to the War Office, London.

Allied Forces (Application of 23 Geo. 5.c.6.)(No.1) Order, 1940 (S.R. & J.1818/1940) contains other provisions in respect to discipline and internal administration of allied forces and other matters, as applied with adaptations and modifications by the Allied Forces (Application of Acts to Coloniss, 22. (No.1; Order, 1941 (S.R. & O. No.155/1941).

6. Operational control.

The detachment of the Morwegian military forces whilst in the Falkland Islands or in any of its dependencies shall for the purposes of defence be under the operational control and direction of the Officer Commanding (British) Troops, Falkland Islands.

I have the honour to refer to previous telegrams regarding the proposal to station a Norwegian detachment at South Georgia and to enclose for your information a copy of the directive which has been issued to the Officer Commanding this detachment.

2. As regards paragraph 5 of Appendix A to the directive, I have to invite your attention to the Allied Forces Act, 1940, (3 & 4 Geo.6 cap 51), the Allied Forces (Application of 23 Geo.5 c.6) (No.1) Order 1940, and the Allied Forces (Application of Acts to Colonies etc.) (No.1) Order, 1941. The first two of these documents were forwarded with Lord Lloyd's circular despatch of the 2nd December, 1940 and the third with my circular despatch of the 28th February, 1941. You will observe that the Allied Forces Act, as applied to the Falkland Islands by the second of the Orders in Council mentioned above, gives certain powers in regard to the administration and discipline of allied forces lawfully present in the Colony

3. The Norwegian detachment has been provided, by their military authorities, with a Norwegian Government flag. The following is a translation of the instructions concerning its use given to the Officer in Command of the detachment:-

> "This flag must under no circumstances be used in any other way than indoors and you must instruct your detachment accordingly."


