In consequence of the serious delay which has recently oucurred in the furnishing of Bills of Entry and payment of Customs Duty on goods imported direct to the West Falklands.

I am directed by His Excellency the Governor to forward to you for your information and guidance a copy of the Customs Consolidation Ordinance of 1332 and to call your particular attention to the provisions of Sections 33, 37 and 38.

These sections were enacted for the benefit and convenience of the Colonists living at a distance from Stanley, and to prevent the necessity of requiring all vessels arriving from Ports outside the Colony to enter at the Custom House in Stanley, and the Governor hopes that for the future the provisions of these sections will be strictly and promptly complied with, and the necessary returns and payments forwarded at once to the Treasurer as the Law requires, and thus obviate the necessity for further Legislation.

The "Sheep Ordinance" of 1367, is not in my opinion satisfactory.

The welfare of the Colony depends chiefly on the prosperity of the farmers, and I think prosecutions for having scub or any other infectious disease, ought to be conducted by Government.

At present if a flock is infected by neighbour's scabby sheep, it appears, that a claim for only £50, can be made.

I do not advocate Government undertaking to clean a flock or run; as an arrangement of this kind, would entail the expense of inspectors, &c. &c.

It would not do for obvious reasons, to offer a reward, for information of the presence of scub.

Let the information be made by the farmers, whose land joins an injected run. officially to Government, and on receipt of this information, let Government serve a notice to the owner of infected run, ordering him to clean his sheep within six months.

If this is not done fine £100 or £50, and increase or double the fine every six months. if the owner or manager does not comply with terms of notice,

If a farmer has scab, at any rate on the West, it is always known to the neighbours. the information quickly comes through the men

If a fllock is infected through contact with a neighbour's sheep, I think all expenses in connection with cleaning the flock or flocks, should be paid by the said neighbours.

The farmers themselves might be made inspectors, and a run declared clean by Government, if two neighbours of the injected run, signed a paper to that effect.

The fact is, that many men work underhanded, or with hands who do not understand their work, and many have insufficient paddock accommodation, so that caring scub is rendered next to impossible; if Government took the matter in hand, they would be compelled to go to work in a methodical manner.

All fines of course go to Government.

I think, an Ordinance run more or less on these lines would work, and have the effect of stamping out scab; under the present Ordinance, I see no possibility of our ever obtaining what all wish for.


