about Bach's brother getting out to him, I told him you would remit any money paid to our Office for his passage out and that the 'Selenia' would be a good opportunity if we should not have occasion to charter a vessel before.

11. On the 18<sup>th</sup> ult. we received the Pacific C<sup>o</sup> Mail Table for next year which occasions a few alterations in ours of 19 Oct 86 as per copies enclosed, and on the 10<sup>th</sup> inst. Mr. Staude's letter informed that the 'Rosmos' Steamers would leave Dartmouth on 21<sup>st</sup> March and 16<sup>th</sup> May next which enabled further additions to be made, these were submitted to the General Post Office who sent yesterday proof of their usual notice giving the dates of the arrival of these Steamers at Stanley on 22 April and 17 June, on my pointing out these are six days earlier than our dates they state that the 'Rosmos' C<sup>o</sup> give these dates so they are probably expediting their steamers and the matter must rest for the present until we get their Itinerary - we shall not print another Mail Table until the early part of next March.

12. As you think Mr. John Dixon's Land at Stanley might be useful to us we have got him to leave the matter in your hands and now send Deeds, Correspondence and copies of his letters to us agreeing to abide by your decision and send Power of Attorney for you to act or sign any legal document necessary.

13. I have the pleasure of reporting that the C<sup>o</sup> has received a Commemorative Diploma and Medal from the Colonial & Indian Exhibition - enclosed is copy of Mr. Leopold Field's letter of 10<sup>th</sup> inst. upon samples of our Tallow we sent to him, as he has been appointed to report upon Oils, Fats &c. from the different Colonies - he speaks very well of our Tallow and we trust care will be taken to keep up the quality as prices are improving - The samples were from the Tallow ex 'Totmes' 18 Nov 86.

14. Enclosed is correspondence with Welch & C<sup>o</sup> upon Timber charter. We have accepted Gilbey's Agency for Wines & Spirits though we must not desert Wilds who have treated us well but perhaps Gilbey's light wines might meet with a little demand. The Wool and Wool Sheds are insured from 1<sup>st</sup> inst. as usual.
