Mr McPhee brought this file to me and asked me to forward it to you.

2. He has discussed p. 19 with the Postmaster.
3. They cannot recommend 22nd July as the release date. From this file it appears that the Printers will not have the stamps ready for delivery until Monday 8th July and the stamps must be here by Monday 15th July (i.e. exactly one week later) in order to allow the Post Office staff the necessary week to prepare the FDC's. They feel the schedule would be too tight. In addition, 22nd July is a mail day and not, therefore, a day on which to release new stamps for sale.
4. The release date suggested by Messrs. Luxton and McPhee is Wednesday, 31st July, provided the FDC's are received with the stamps.
5. I am given to understand that Y.E. intends sending a telegram in reply to p. 19. Could confirmation be sought that the FDC's will be forwarded with the stamps pl?
