Hon. Col. Secty,

The Rates of postage on letters to the U.K. and other parts of the British Empire is 1d per ounce (Order in Council of 30th August 1907)

2. By Order in Council dated the 29th August 1918 the rates of postage were raised to 1d for the first ounce, and one half penny for each succeeding ounce, or 1/2d for an ounce. A further Order in Council was made on the 5th February 1920 continuing these rates until six months after the termination of the War. The additional rate ended on the 10th July 1920, since which date the postage charged has been that set out in the Order in Council of 30th August 1907.

3. In view of the fact that in some Colonies the postage rate has been increased to 2d per ounce, I think that the postage rate from this Colony might be so increased.
