Sir,

In confirmation of my message 1752 of 3rd instant, I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the following arrangements have been made for W/T communication between Falkland Islands W/T Station and Cerrito during such periods as cable communication between Montevideo and Port Stanley is interrupted:-

- (a) Falkland Islands transmits messages at 4.0 a.m. GMT daily on a 4500 metre wave length.
- (b) Cerrito transmits messages at 2.30 a.m. GMT daily on a 1250 metre wave length.
- (c) Charges for messages to be in accordance with the ordinary international tariff.

2. The Officer-in-Charge of the Falkland Islands W/T Station has been instructed accordingly.
