Message X80/I from Buenos Aires to Wilkins Hektoria Montevideo via Stanley with text as quoted was handed-in in Buenos Aires at 22.45 on 21st. and delivered on the same day.

It is suggested that the original message was wrongly addressed as quoted "Wilkins Hektoria Montevideo" in which case it woul remain at the Cerrito Station for one week after which the sender would be advised that no communication had been established with the S/S"Hektoria". On receipt of this advice the sender probably redirected the message "via Stanley" thus accounting for the dating of the message as 21st.

Message I2 from S/S "Hektoria" handed in I0.00 on 30th. was forwarded by S/S"Ronald" to-day.

A daily schedule at 2I.00 G.M.T. was arranged with S/S"Hektoria" and calls are sent out daily at this time. At first this schedule was kept regularily but later our calls were only answered occasionally and at present no reply is received. This schedule was arranged on short-wave at the request of the ship but it is not considered satisfactory for short distance work. It is regretted that Sir Herbert Wilkins has been inconvenienced by irregular communications but everything was done at this end to ensure a regular service with the "Hektoria" and in fact still is.
