Circular No. 54. Owing to cable congestion desirable that all telegrams in Government Telegraph Code and Interdepartmental Cypher including Indiv should be routed "via cable or wireless" to ensure transmission by quickest route available. Use of Confidential Code, which still requires "IO" routing, should henceforth be restricted to non urgent messages.
