Sir,

With reference to your despatch No. 134 of the 23rd December, 1913, and to previous correspondence connected therewith, I have the honour to report that on the opening of the admiralty Cable Office in this Colony in August, 1913, I arranged that all Government telegrams received and forwarded should be accounted for hereafter, and that all private telegrams should be charged and paid for at the time of handing in at the Cable Office. The moneys received at the Cable Office for private telegrams to be deposited in the Colonial Treasury at the end of each month to the credit of the Admiralty.

2. From August last to the 30th April, 1916, cable messages have been sent from this Colony, made up as follows:-

3. In respect of the private telegrams the sum of £593. 12. 0 (£498. 1. 11 plus £4. 10. 1 for prepaid replies) is on deposit in the Colonial Treasury to the credit of the Admiralty. The Western Telegraph Company have yet to be paid for both the Government and the private telegrams forwarded.

4. I enclose certified statements I have had prepared by the Postmaster showing the number of Telegrams sent each month, and the charges made for the same. These statements have been prepared from copies of the original messages, and from the abstract of forwarded messages furnished by the Officer in Charge of the Cable Office.

5. Under cover of your despatch No. 13 of the 22nd October, 1918, you informed me that the rates on all telegrams between the United Kingdom and the Falkland Islands sent over the new cable, are $\frac{2}{11}$ a word for Government Telegrams, and $\frac{3}{11}$ a word for private telegrams. No mention is however made of rates on telegrams forwarded from here to places other than the United Kingdom, and up to the present I have received no instructions on the subject.

6. The Officer in Charge of the Admiralty Cable Office informs me that on opening the Cable Station in this Colony, he was instructed by the Traffic Accountant of the Western Telegraph Company, that the rates from Port Stanley would be the Monte Video rates, plus an additional rate of $\frac{1}{2}$ per word for the Monte Video - Port Stanley (Admiralty) Section, in all cases except

in the case of Government Telegrams from Port Stanley to the United Kingdom, in which case the rate would be ^{u d} 2/1¹/₂ per word.

7. Acting on these instructions private telegrams forwarded from Port Stanley to their several destinations have been charged the Monte Video rate plus the additional ^{u d} 1/2 per word. A like additional charge of ^{u d} 1/3 per word has also been made on all Government Telegrams sent forward to any destination other than the United Kingdom. I am not sure however that this is correct.

8. It appears to me that the Admiralty should be given full credit for all private telegrams passing over the Monte Video - Port Stanley (Admiralty) Section, and that no charge should be made for Government Telegrams.

9. In case the matter has not yet received attention I venture to submit for consideration that, on all telegrams sent over the Monte Video - Port Stanley (Admiralty) Cable, other than those sent to the United Kingdom, the rates for which have already been fixed, the following rates might be adopted:-

For Government Telegrams.

To or from Monte Video free of charge, the Western Telegraph Company being allowed a half penny a word for handling the telegrams at Monte Video.

Transit from any place beyond Monte Video (except United Kingdom) the Company's fixed rates be charges and paid to the Company, less a deduction of 25%.

For

For Private Telegrams.

To or from Monte Video a charge of $\frac{1}{2}$ a word
be paid to the Admiralty, the Western Telegraph
Company being allowed a half penny a word for
handling telegrams at Monte Video.

To or from any place beyond Monte Video, in
addition to the $\frac{1}{2}$ a word rate, the fixed rates
of the Company to be charged and paid to the
Company.

between the United Kingdom and this Colony, on the
telegrams forwarded from this Colony is settled,
payment of the claims of the Western Telegraph Company
cannot be made.

10. In considering this matter the Claim of the Admiralty to a rebate on Government Telegrams sent to this Colony from places other than the United Kingdom, during the period August, 1916, to 30th April, 1918, will no doubt be borne in mind and be dealt with at the same time.



With reference to my despatch No. 92 of 15th May, 1916 forwarding statements of telegrams sent from here during the months of August 1915 to April 30th, 1916, I have now the honour to forward herewith certified statements prepared by the Postmaster showing the number of telegrams despatched from the Admiralty Cable Office in this Colony during the month of May, 1916.

2. I submit that payment for these telegrams cannot be settled until the question, raised by my despatch above referred to, of the proportionate parts to be paid to the Admiralty and to the Eastern Telegraph Company is settled by the Admiralty and the Postmaster General in England. I have as in the case of the previous months, August 1915 to April 1916, prepared a separate statement, a copy of which I enclose, showing in detail how the amounts of the several telegrams forwarded from here in May are arrived at.

3. It will be noted that on the statement of private telegrams a sum of £239. 1. 11 is to be collected from the Editor of the Daily Chronicle in respect of the urgent messages £71. 15. 8, and one press message £167. 2. 5. These messages were sent by Sir Ernest Shackleton on his arrival at Port Stanley on the 31st May.

The Officer in Charge of the Cable Station here informs me that as is instructed by the Superintendent of the Western Telegraph Company at Monte Video, that the Press rate from Port Stanley to Monte Video is 2/8 a word, being one half of the ordinary rate. The Press rate from Monte Video to the United Kingdom is 1/4 a word.

5. No mention of a press rate from Port Stanley was made in the letter of the General Post Office, London of the 25th October, 1913, a copy of which you forwarded to me under cover of your despatch No. 112 of the 22nd October, 1913. I, *however,* submit the rate of 7/8 a word might be approved.
