Commander Crawford brought this paper to the Office and explained that the usual charge for registering a telegraphic address was £1.1.0, that messages arriving under an unregistered telegraphic address were held up in the Office of receipt, a notice being posted inviting the addressees to apply for them, that fees received for registration <sup>in Stanley</sup> of telegraphic addresses ~~in Stanley~~ should be credited to the Admiralty & fees received at Port Bay should be retained by the Colonial Government, and that this application of Mr. Deane's, if approved, should be registered at Port Bay.




2. You should open a suitable book to be used for the registration of Cable addresses and particulars such as the name of the person or firm registering, and the cable address registered, should be duly noted therein.
